February 7 th Christ the Center:	<u>Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!</u> II Corinthians 5:17	I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. <u>Galatians 2:20</u>
February 14 th Obedience to Christ:	<u>Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship.</u> Romans 12: 1	Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him. <u>John 14:21</u>
February 28 th The Word:	<u>All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness...</u> II Timothy 3:16	Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. <u>Joshua 1:8</u>
March 7 th Prayer:	<u>If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.</u> John 15:7	Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. <u>Philippians 4:6-7</u>
March 14 th Fellowship:	<u>For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them.</u> Matthew 18:20	And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching. <u>Hebrews 10:24-25</u>
March 21 st Witnessing:	<u>"Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men."</u> Matthew 4:19	I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. <u>Romans 1:16</u>
